

GUIDELINE FOR NON-MEMBERS ATTENDING MEETINGS

PURPOSE

To record our policy for non-members' attendance at our meetings.

SCOPE

It applies to visitors, which includes prospective members and members of other u3as who are not Associate members of our u3a.

POLICY

1. A visitor may attend free of charge for:
 - One General Meeting - their name is recorded in the Visitors Book and
 - An Interest Group meeting on one occasion, making a contribution of any charge a Group member normally makes, for example for refreshments or materials. Their name is recorded in the attendance register.
2. In order to attend further meetings, a visitor will need to join the High Wycombe and District u3a. If already a member of another u3a, they can become an Associate Member and their subscription will be reduced by the Third Age Trust subscription applicable at the time.

As an exception to the above, members of other local u3as may participate in some of our shared outside Groups, for example Croquet, Ten Pin Bowling, Bird Watching, on an on-going basis without joining our u3a. They pay the same attendance charge as the High Wycombe and District u3a members.

ACCESSIBILITY

A member who cannot participate in a chosen activity without help, may bring a companion/carer with them without charge. For the time they are in attendance the companion/carer will be covered by the liability insurance provided by the Third Age Trust.

The only exception to this is a professionally employed carer who would have to be covered by their individual liability policy.
